VCE students across GSV's 24 Independent Girls Schools were no doubt a bit emotional when they played their last Basketball matches last week.

With only a combined Intermediate and Senior (Yr 9 -12) Cricket competition still being played, most Year 11 and 12 girls have concluded their school sporting commitments in order to focus on their VCE exams.

The girls bade farewell to school sport with a condensed season of Basketball, playing two matches each week.

Star of the Sea and MLC finished the season undefeated and on top of the ladder in their zones and will play the Grand Final next week at MSAC.

Earlier in the year MLC won the GSV Basketball Tournament, but to date, the Senior Weekly Basketball Grand Final has eluded them. The girls will go into the GSV Grand Final match brimming with confidence, having reached the Semi Finals in Basketball Victoria's McDonalds Cup recently.

In other Senior sport, the Senior Cricket competition is shaping up predictably with Star, LMH, Sacre Coeur, OLMC and Ruyton all undefeated after round three.

The Intermediate and Junior Basketball seasons have only just got underway, But already the schools with traditionally strong Basketball teams are featuring, including Fintona, Firbank, Genazzano, Korowa, MLC, OLMC and Star of the Sea.

This is the first year that the Junior Waterpolo will progress to a finals series, but Lauriston and Korowa have strong histories in the sport and are likely to feature. So far, Korowa, Lauriston, Tintern and Ivanhoe are all undefeated.
