## **GSV seniors get ready for finals**

Korowa and Star of the Sea College will play off in the finals of the GSV softball competition next week (4<sup>th</sup> April) after convincing wins in their semi-finals matches on Monday (21st March).

Korowa remain undefeated for the season having won their match against Tintern in convincing style (15 -1) at Waverley Park and will go into the final feeling confident of improving their 2004 result as runners up to Shelford in the 2004 competition.

Star of the Sea prevailed over Ruyton 12 – 9 in their semi-final match. Star is also looking forward to contesting the final against Korowa, having come second to Korowa in their zone last year, which prevented them from contesting the 2004 finals series.

MLC was particularly dominant in the A grade senior pairs tennis semi-final (23 to 15 games) winning three sets and only narrowly losing the fourth set against St Catherine's at Melbourne Park. The match between Sacre Coeur and St Margaret's was more closely fought, with Sacre Coeur holding out, winning 23 games (two sets) to St Margaret's 20 games (two sets). MLC and Sacre Coeur will now play off in the final on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2005 at Melbourne Park.

Melbourne defeated Kilvington 157 to 101 in the final of the indoor cricket match at Oakleigh Indoor Sports Centre. This is the first year indoor cricket has been contested at senior level in the GSV competition, but both Melbourne and Kilvington have featured strongly in the junior and intermediate competition in previous years.
