2017 Track Cycling Skills Program **General Information**

What is it all about?

GSV, in partnership with Cycling Victoria, presents the 2017 GSV Track Cycling Skills Program. The program is open to all students from Year 7-12 at GSV schools, aimed at students with little or no previous track cycling experience.

Over five sessions, you will experience the thrill of track cycling in a world class facility alongside accredited coaches. You will learn to master a 42° bank track, rolling turns and discover a variety of track cycling skills, such as flying laps, time trials and team pursuits just to name a few! No previous track cycling experience necessary! Provision of a professional track bike is included.

Meet GSV staff trackside 10 minutes prior to the start of each session. A GSV staff member will be in attendance for the duration of each session and this person will assist with the administration and organisation of the program.

Registration Confirmation/Cancellations/Withdrawals:

GSV will confirm with your Head of Sport your registration. Please check with them to verify your place in the program after the closing date.

On the date of close of entry, GSV is required to confirm numbers and staffing with the service provider (Cycling Victoria) and, as such, no refunds can be given after this date.

Minimum numbers apply for the program to proceed. Should the program be cancelled due to lack of numbers, registered participants will be notified shortly after the closing date of entries. A full refund will be given in this case.
